ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Qualifications

Must be a H.F.A. Member. Membership forms available.

Holland Friends of Art (HFA) members to submit 1 or 2 pieces of quality artwork.

ALL mediums considered.

Artwork must have been produced within the last two years. Submit only artwork not previously displayed in a HFA exhibit.

Entry Procedures

- (1) Please bring your pieces to Holland Area Arts Council on one of the drop-off days listed above. No work may be entered prior to or after the entry dates.
- (2) After your art work is approved for admission to the show, make sure you fill out all of the information on the sign-in sheet that will be provided, before you leave.

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Framing & Size Requirements

- 1 No photographs of your submissions (in place of your artwork) will be accepted.
- 2 Each artwork must complete, dry, framed, and ready to hang with wire.
- 3 Do not use saw-tooth hangers or poster frames.
- **4 Maximum size for 2D artwork is 30**" x 20" or 600 squ. Inches. 3D art sizes may be limited, as well.
- 5 You may use the HFA label(s) that are provided on our website.
- 6 Additional HFA labels will be provided at the desk when you drop of your art work.
- 7 Print your name, title of work, medium, phone number, email, home address and price of the work. (Please print clearly)Please attach the HFA label to the back of each piece of your art work.

Notification of Acceptance or Nonacceptance into the Juried Show

Each member, who enters artwork into the HFA members show, will be notified if your artwork(s) will be or will not be included into the show,by November 15, 2022. Notification will be via email or by phone,if no email is available.

Pick-up Procedures

Any artwork **not accepted into the show** may be picked up on (**TBA**), during normal HAAC business hours. Make sure you sign-out your artwork at the front desk.

Artwork **included into the show** may be picked up **(TBA)**, during normal HAAC business hours. Make sure you sign-out your artwork at the front desk.

Note: The pickup dates are important. If you are unable to pick up your artwork personally, please arrange for someone else to pick it up for you. The HAAC and HFA will not be responsible for any artwork left, after the dates listed above. Please make sure your artwork is signed out, at time of pick up. Every precaution and care will be taken with your artwork, but HAAC and HFA are not responsible for any damage or loss of artwork.

HFA Membership

The HFA Spring Show is a members only show. HFA members may renew their membership at the HAAC drop-off site. New members are welcome to join. The annual membership fee is \$20. **Cash or check only, for payment, please.** Checks should be made out to Holland Friends of Art.

HAAC Commission

The Arts Council will handle all show sales with a 30% commission.
